Instructions:

Then you should choose a location in the US where an important moment in the Civil Rights movement occurred (for example Selma, Alabama or Memphis, Tennessee) if you want your poster to be about the Civil Rights movement, or a location in US or the United Kingdom (for example London or Bristol) if you want your poster to be about the Black Lives Matter movement.

Your poster should include pictures, graphs and information about the place you have chosen and what happened there either in connection with the Civil Rights movement or the Black Lives Matter movement.

Think about the values we hold in our school and how we strive to be inclusive, compassionate, reflective, supportive and transformative.

Think about what we can do to make sure Black Lives Matter.

If you could give a message to the world, what would it be?

Send us a picture of your poster and we will make a year group photo. The best poster will win a prize! Make it count!
