Dear Parents and Carers,

Visitors to our school always comment on how smart our students look as they move around school. We are proud of our students, and the way in which they wear their uniform. We are grateful for your support in ensuring our school uniform is worn correctly, both in and out of school.

However, I am writing to highlight a couple of particular aspects of uniform which some students have not fully adhered to recently, and we are asking for your support to help ensure every student is able to arrive at school in full uniform, properly equipped for the day, so that she can be fully focussed on her learning.

A full list of uniform is on page 8 of the student handbook and is also on our website. In particular we would like to highlight that the Governors uniform policy does not permit hair ornaments (including beads or large bows), and footwear must be shoes not boots. We also expect students to wear their skirts without rolling it over at the waistband. As the weather becomes colder, students should have a plain black or navy coat that fits over their blazer. For the few students who wear incorrect uniform, we will issue an appropriate sanction.

We do have a small number of coats suitable for school which have been donated to us. Please contact your pastoral inclusion officer if you would like your child to have one of them. In addition, if you have any items of school uniform in good condition that are no longer of use to you, please donate them to us to help others. If you have any questions regarding school uniform, please contact your child's Director of Learning via the school office.
